BRISBANE CUP FOR FAST 'N' FAMOUS MARE

It's onwards and upwards to the **Gr.2 Brisbane Cup** for Nearco Stud's gutsy **Fast 'N' Famous** mare **Quintessential** following her **Gr.3 Chairman's Handicap** triumph at Eagle Farm last Saturday.

The John Sargent-trained galloper was a star of **Queensland's Winter Carnival** last year, claiming the **Gr.1 Queensland Oaks** a week before running a gallant second to **Savabeel's** son **Brambles** in the **Derby**.

"She's bounced through the race surprisingly well," said Nearco Stud's Racing Manager, Adrian Clark.

"From here we'll look to the Gr.2 Brisbane Cup. She's hit top form again and seems to like Eagle Farm, but the key to getting her there is the weight she is likely to receive.

"At this point she is nominated for the Premiers Cup on the 25th of May, but depending on the weight she receives, she may start a week later in the weight-for-age Eagle Farm Cup instead."

Purchased by Clark for \$70,000 at the 2010 NZB Select Yearling Sale, **Quintessential's** has returned A\$547,809 in earnings via a career spanning five wins, and including black-type distinction in the **Gr.1 Queensland Oaks**, the **Gr.3 WRC Desert Gold** Stakes and the **Gr.3 BRC Chairman's Hcp**.

Bred by Trelawney Stud, Quintessential is Fast N Famous' second stakes winner this term behind Our Famous Eve.



Quintessential represents the only racehorse bred on the Fast 'N' Famous (s)/ Sword Dance (ds) cross.

HIGH PRAISE FOR I DO

Allan Sharrock couldn't have paid the **No Excuse Needed** mare **I Do** a higher compliment on Saturday when he rated her favourably with multiple Group One winner **Shez Sinsational** in the wake of her trouncing of rivals in the **Listed Rotorua Stakes.**



"When I had the good brown mare (Shez Sinsational) there wasn't much between them in ability," Sharrock said.

Sharrock races I Do with Mark Chittick, who had not one but three reasons to take satisfaction from the feature event. Waikato Stud also bred the No Excuse Needed runner-up No Excuse Maggie, who came from last, as well as the fourth placegetter Huffer (Pins), which the stud race with the Huffer Syndicate.

With further improvement tipped and a possible **Gr.1 NZ Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes** tilt ahead, Sharrock is very much looking forward to campaigning **I Do** as a 6YO next season.

"I Do has been a real daddy long-legs, but the improvement in her over the last 12 months has been immense. She's spelling now, but if she improves even half as much as what she has over the last 12 months, we will have a serious racehorse on our hands," he said.

I Do is the 15th individual stakes winner for **No Excuse Needed** and is the 11th individual WS-bred stakes winner this season.



There have been 34 runners bred on the No Excuse Needed (s)/ O'Reilly (ds) cross. Of these, 67.6% (23) are winners and a remarkable 14.7% (5) are stakes winners. The 5 stakes winners comprise Daffodil (Gr.1 x 3), No Excuse Maggie, I Do, Masquerade and Takeanotherchance.
