### PEDIGREE POINTERS

#### with Gareth Downey

Pedigree analysis is certainly a fascinating pursuit. When used in conjunction with matching a mare with stallion options that suit her physically, it can also be a powerful tool in planning matings.

In terms of pedigree analysis, we have wonderful tools available to use these days. Two of those are available for use here, so please do feel very welcome to use the **TrueNicks** and **Goldmine** links below.

The wonderfully honest **No Excuse Maggie** notched up her 7<sup>th</sup> win last weekend, and she is a good example of how we can use **TrueNicks** for pedigree research. If we enter her dam, **Maggie O'Reilly**, into **TrueNicks**, we see the mating with **No Excuse Needed** is rated as an A++. If we enter **Maggie O'Reilly** into **Goldmine**, we can see it comes up as a 20/20 mating. Both tools, using different analytical approaches clearly suggest that the mating between **Maggie O'Reilly** (and therefore any **O'Reilly** mare) and **No Excuse Needed** looks like an excellent one.
